

Health and Safety Requirements for Visitors

The Wignacourt Museum has put into place the following measures in accordance with the Public health Act Chapter 465 of the Laws of Malta.

We ask that all visitors adhere to these recommended guidelines for their safety and the safety of the museum staff

- Visitors are asked to respect the social distancing rule of 2 m when queuing outside or inside the museum
- A mask or visor must be worn at all times whilst on the premises
- A body temperature check will be performed prior to entrance. Individuals having a body temperature exceeding 37.2 °C will be denied entrance
- The museum has the right to refuse entry to visitors if they are visibly unwell or have respiratory symptoms including coughing, fever shortness of breath, runny nose or sore throat.
- Visitors are asked to limit the amount of personal belongings they bring with them
- Some personal data will be collected on entry for the sole purpose of contact tracing
- Visitors are to make use of the hand sanitizers provided
- The revised capacity of the site is 300 pax based on 1 person per 4 m²
- Social distancing is to be practiced throughout the site and individuals are asked to keep a
 distance of 2 m between them and other visitors at all times
- Doors and windows will be left open where possible for added ventilation
